PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Welcome to the Idaho Falls City Council Meeting.

Regularly scheduled City Council meetings are open to the general public. City Council meetings are also live-streamed and archived on <u>the City website</u>. Please be aware that the meeting agenda will differ from the published version if amendments to the agenda are made by the Council during the meeting.

The Council encourages public input. While a general public comment option is not required by Idaho law, the Idaho Falls City Council welcomes general public input as part of regular City Council meetings. General public comment will be allowed for up to 20 minutes. However, citizens are always welcome to contact their Council representatives via e-mail or telephone, as listed on the Council is committed to an atmosphere that promotes equal opportunity, civility, mutual respect, property decorum and freedom from discrimination or harassment.

Those who wish to address City Council during the council meetings are encouraged to adhere to the guidelines below.

Public Comment Guidelines

Speakers are encouraged to:

- State their name and city of residence.
- Focus comments on matters within the purview of the City Council.
- Limit comments to three (3) minutes or less.
- Refrain from repeating information already presented to preserve time for others to speak. Large groups are encouraged to select one or two speakers to represent the voice of the entire group.
- Practice civility and courtesy. City leaders have the right and the responsibility to maintain order and decorum during the meeting. Time may be curtailed for those speakers whose comments are profane or disruptive in nature.
- Refrain from comments on issues involving matters currently pending before the City's Planning and Zoning Commission or other matters that require legal due process, including public hearings, City enforcement actions, and pending City personnel disciplinary matters.
- Comments that pertain to activities or performance of individual City employees should be shared directly with the City's Human Resources Director (208-612-8248), the City's Legal Department (208-612-8178) or with the Office of the Mayor (208-612-8235).

Public Hearing Guidelines

- In-person Comment. Because public hearings must follow various procedures required by law, please wait to offer your comments until comment is invited/indicated. Please address comments directly to the Council and try to limit them to three (3) minutes.
- Written Comment. The public may provide written comments via postal mail sent to City Hall or via email sent to the City Clerk at IFClerk@idahofalls.gov. Comments will be distributed to the members of the Council and become a part of the official public hearing record. Written testimony must be received no later than forty-eight (48) hours prior to the date of the hearing to ensure inclusion in the permanent City record.
- Remote Comment. When available, the public may provide live testimony remotely via the WebEx meeting platform using a phone or a computer. Those desiring public hearing access should send a valid and accurate email address to virtualattend@idahofalls.gov no later than twenty-four (24) hours prior to the date of the hearing so log-in information can be sent prior to the meeting. Please indicate which public hearing the testimony is intended for on the agenda. Please note that this remote option will not be available for all meetings.

A. Idaho Falls Power

1) Sole Source Purchase of Electric Revenue Meters

23-173

IFP chose Elster Meters and their Automated Metering (AMI) system in 2012 via a competitive process. The decision to purchase Elster's AMI system subsequently limited meter purchases to Elster meters since they are the only meters capable of communicating with this proprietary AMI system. Elster has since been acquired by Honeywell Corporation.

IFP recommends that the City Council designate Honeywell to be the sole source supplier due to IFP's multi-million dollar investment in the Elster AMI system, which now is compatible only with Honeywell meters. This is in recognition of the fact that "compatibly of equipment, components, accessories, computer software, replacement parts, or service the paramount consideration" to provide essential, uninterrupted service to IFP customers. This satisfies the requirements set forth in Idaho Code § 67-2808(2)(a)(ii).

Action Item:

Pursuant to State Code sole purchasing requirements, Council finds that the City's Elster AMI system is compatible with only Honeywell meters and because compatibly of equipment, component, accessories, computer software, replacement parts, or service is the City's paramount consideration of purchase of the Honeywell meters, Council authorizes City staff to advertise the City's intent to make a sole source procurement pursuant to Idaho Code and authorizes staff to then issue purchase orders to Honeywell Corporation or their distributor for IFP's revenue meters (or take other action deemed appropriate).

B. City Attorney

1) Day Care Ordinance - Background Check Alignment with State Code

23-177

This Ordinance would align the City's background check for Day Care facility owners and childcare workers to the same standards set by the Idaho State Legislature in Idaho Code § 39-1113.

2) Resolution - Clarification of Resolution 2021-11 and Resolution 2022-16 Condemnation of Property for Expansion, Improvement, and Protection of the Idaho Falls Regional Airport

23-178

On April 22, 2021, the City adopted Resolution No. 2021-11 to initiate legal proceedings to acquire property adjacent to the Idaho Falls Regional Airport ("Airport") for the expansion, improvement, or protection of the Airport. Resolution 2022-16 was adopted in order to correct an obvious scrivener's error to Resolution No 2021-11, to clarify the City's legal authority, and did not substantively change any decision or action taken to date by Council. Both Resolution No. 2021-11 and Resolution 2022-16 identified that the land to be acquired was owned by Johnson Legacy, LLC, and identified that property by the correct Bonneville County tax parcel number (RP02N37E014248).

As the condemnation legal action proceeded, an error in the legal description of the property was discovered. This resolution corrects that error and includes the revised legal description in its Resolution No. 2021-11 and No. 2022-16 and, to such, reaffirms that the prior Resolutions authorized the acquisition of the entire parcel of land owned by Johnson Legacy, LLC, as identified by Bonneville County tax parcel number RP02N37E014248. This resolution does not substantively change prior Resolutions No. 2021-11 and No. 2022-16 or any decision or action taken to date by the Council related to them or their respective intent and, as such, will relate-back to the date of the original Resolution No. 2021-11.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO; AMENDING TITLE 6 CHAPTER 3, TO ALIGN CITY CRIMINAL DAY CARE DISQUALIFICATIONS WITH THE STATE CODE; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, CODIFICATION, PUBLICATION BY SUMMARY, AND ESTABLISHING EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Idaho Code provisions regulating child care (Title 39, Chapter 12) were promulgated based upon broad input from parents, child care advocates, child care providers, and other citizens across the State; and

WHEREAS, as part of the day care statute, the Idaho Legislature instituted the criminal activity disqualifications in the current Day Care statute (Idaho Code Section 39-1113) in an effort to responsibly regulate the provision of day care services to children; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code Sections 39-1101 and 39-1108 mandate that a municipal Day Care Ordinance be at least as stringent as Idaho Code day care provisions; and

WHEREAS, the City's current Day Care disqualification are significantly more restrictive than those of the Idaho Code; and

WHEREAS, after a careful comparison of the criminal history disqualifications in the Idaho Code (I.C. 39-1113) with the City's current Day Care Ordinance (IFCC Section 6-3-8), Council has determined that the Idaho Code disqualifications reasonably and adequately protect children, as well as parents and guardians of such children; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to amend its current Day Care Ordinance (Title 6, Chapter 3) to align with similar sections of the Idaho Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Title 6, Chapter 3 of the City Code of the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, is hereby amended as follows:

6-3-8: LICENSES/CERTIFICATION, DENIAL, SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION: A license or certification applied for or issued under this Chapter shall be denied, suspended, or revoked:

A. Where Applicant; Licensee; Owner; Operator; Child Care Worker; Resident; Volunteer, On-Site Non-Provider; spouse or significant other of an Owner:

- 1. Has been found guilty of, plead guilty to, received a withheld judgment, or admitted to the elements of any offense involving neglect, any physical injury, or other abuse of a child, including the following enumerated crimes, or any substantially similar provision of a foreign criminal violation, notwithstanding the form of judgment:
- B. Felony injury of a child, section 18-1501, Idaho Code.
 - a. The sexual abuse of a child under sixteen (16) years of age, Section 18- 1506, Idaho Code.
 - b. The ritualized abuse of a child under eighteen (18) years of age, Section 18-1506A, Idaho Code.
 - c. The sexual exploitation of a child, section 18-1507 or 18-1507A, Idaho Code.
 - d. Sexual abuse of a child under the age of sixteen (16) years, Section 18-1506, Idaho Code.
 - e. Lewd conduct with a child under the age of sixteen (16) years, Section 18-1508, Idaho Code.
 - f. The sale or barter of a child for adoption or other purposes, Section 18- 1511, Idaho Code.
 - g. Murder in any degree, Section 18-4001 or 18-4003, Idaho Code.
 - h. Assault with intent to murder, Section 18-4015, Idaho Code.
 - i. Voluntary manslaughter, Section 18-4006, Idaho Code.
 - j. Rape, Section 18-6101, Idaho Code.
 - k. Incest, Section 18-6602, Idaho Code.
 - l. Forcible sexual penetration by use of foreign object, Section 18-6608, Idaho Code.
 - m. Abuse, neglect, or exploitation of a vulnerable adult, Section 18-1505, Idaho Code.
 - n. Aggravated, first degree, second degree, and third-degree arson, Sections 18-801 through 18-805, Idaho Code.
 - o. Nonconsensual sexual contact that is prohibited by Section 18-6605, Idaho Code, and whose conviction is entered before July 1, 2022.
 - p. Kidnapping, Sections 18-4501 through 18-4503, Idaho Code.

- q. Mayhem, Section 18-5001, Idaho Code.
- r. Poisoning, Section 18-4014 or 18-5501, Idaho Code.
- s. Robbery, Section 18-6501, Idaho Code.
- t. Stalking in the first degree, Section 18-7905, Idaho Code.
- u. Video voyeurism, Section 18-6609, Idaho Code.
- v. Enticing of children, Section 18-1509 or 18-1509A, Idaho Code.
- w. Inducing individuals under eighteen (18) years of age into prostitution, Section 18-5609, Idaho Code.
- x. Inducing person under eighteen (18) years of age to patronize a prostitute, Section 18-5611, Idaho Code.
- y. Any felony punishable by death or life imprisonment.
- aa. Attempt, Section 18-306, Idaho Code, conspiracy, Section 18-1701, Idaho Code, or accessory after the fact, Section 18-205, Idaho Code, to commit any of the crimes designated in this subsection.
- bb. Felony domestic violence, Section 18-918(2), Idaho Code.
- cc. Any offense requiring registration on a state sex offender registry or the national sexsec offender registry.
- dd. Sexual abuse of an animal, section 18-6602, Idaho Code.
- ee. Sexual abuse of human remains, section 18-6603, Idaho Code.
- ddff. Attempt, Section 18-306, Idaho Code, conspiracy, Section 18-1701, Idaho Code, or accessory after the fact, Section 18-205, Idaho Code, to commit any of the crimes designated in this Subsection.
- Had their parental rights restricted or terminated by a Child protection action under Idaho Code, Section 16-1601 et seq., or Child custody termination action under Idaho Code, Section 16-2001 et seq.
- 3. Where a registered sex offender resides on the Premises where Day Care services are provided.
- C. Where Applicant; Licensee; Owner; Operator; Child Care Worker; Resident; Volunteer, On- Site Non-Provider; spouse or significant other of an Owner has been found guilty of, plead guilty to, or received a withheld judgment, or admitted to the elements-of any of the

following enumerated crimes, or any substantially similar provision of foreign criminal violation, notwithstanding the form of judgment(s) for any offense involving neglect, any physical injury to, or other abuse of a child, or any of the following offenses or a similar provision in another jurisdiction, for a period of ten (10) five (5) years immediately preceding the date of application for license or renewal:

- 1. Aggravated assault, Section 18-905, Idaho Code.
- 2. Aggravated battery, Section 18-907(1), Idaho Code.
- 3. Burglary, Section 18-1401, Idaho Code.
- 4. Felony theft, Sections 18-2403 and 18-2407(1), Idaho Code.
- 5. Forgery of a financial transaction card, Section 18-3123, Idaho Code.
- 6. Fraudulent use of a financial transaction card or number, Section 18-3124, Idaho Code.
- 7. Forgery or counterfeiting, Chapter 36, Title 18, Idaho Code.
- 8. Misappropriation of personal identifying information, Section 18-3126, Idaho Code.

Insurance fraud, Section 41-293, Idaho Code.

- 9. Damage to or destruction of insured property, Section 41-294, Idaho Code.
- 10. Public assistance fraud, Section 56-227, Idaho Code.
- 11. Provider fraud, Section 56-227A, Idaho Code.
- 12. Attempted strangulation, Section 18-923, Idaho Code.
- 13. Misdemeanor injury to a child, Section 18-1501(2), Idaho Code.
- D. Disseminating obscene material to minors, as defined in Sections 18-1513 through 18-1515, Idaho Code.
- E.D. A felony controlled-substance offense.
 - 1. Attempt, Section 18-306, Idaho Code, conspiracy, 18-1701, Idaho Code, or accessory after the fact, Section 18-205, Idaho Code, to commit any of the crimes designated in this Subsection.
- F. Where Applicant; Licensee; Owner; Operator; Child Care Worker; Resident; Volunteer, On-Site Non-Provider; spouse or significant other of an Owner has been found guilty of, plead guilty to, or received a withheld judgment, or admitted to the elements of any of the following enumerated crimes, or any substantially similar provision of foreign criminal violation, notwithstanding the form of judgment(s) for any offense involving neglect, any

physical injury to, or other abuse of a child, or any of the following offenses or a similar provision in another jurisdiction, for a period of five (5) years immediately preceding the date of application for license or renewal:

- 1. Transporting a minor in a motor vehicle while under the influence, Section 18-1501(3), Idaho Code.
- 2. Violation of a Civil Protection Order or No Contact Order, Section 18-920, Idaho Code
- 3. A misdemeanor controlled-substance related offense.
- 4. Misdemeanor domestic violence, Section 18-918(3), Idaho Code.
- 5. Misdemeanor Assault or Battery, Sections 18-902 and 18-903, Idaho Code
- 6. Stalking in the second degree, Section 18-7906, Idaho Code.
- 7. Disturbing the Peace, Section 18 6409, Idaho Code
- 8. Petit Theft, Section 18-6409
- G. For any Applicant; Licensee; Owner; Operator; Child Care Worker; Resident; Volunteer, On–Site Non-Provider; spouse or significant other of an Owner, where there is evidence demonstrating that they have been committed pursuant to Title 66, Chapter 3, Idaho Code, or similar provision in another jurisdiction, as a voluntary or involuntary patient for mental health, drug, or alcohol treatment, within the past year from the date of application.
- <u>H.E.</u> For any Child Care Facility, unless all applicable codes, and other pertinent provisions of all City ordinances, including health requirements herein, as far as can be determined, are being complied with.
- 4.F. For any Applicant; Licensee; Owner; Operator; Child Care Worker; Resident; Volunteer, On- Site Non-Provider; spouse or significant other of an Owner, where there is evidence demonstrating to the City that health or safety problems exist or are probable. No Applicant; Licensee; Owner; Operator; Child Care Worker; Resident; Volunteer, On-Site Non-Provider; spouse or significant other of an Owner shall be qualified to receive a license under this Chapter for a period of no less than one (1) year from the date of the health and/or safety problems which resulted in denial or revocation of a license under this Chapter.
- J.G. For any Applicant; Licensee; Owner; Operator; Child Care Worker; Resident; Volunteer, On- Site Non-Provider; Spouse or significant other of an Owner presiding at the Premises, who has supplied false or misleading information, failed or refused to disclose any information required on the application form, or refused to authorize the police investigation required herein. Applicant; Licensee; Owner; Operator; Child Care Worker;

Resident; Volunteer, On- Site Non-Provider; spouse or significant other of an Owner presiding at the Premises shall be able to apply to receive a license under this Chapter for a period of less than six (6) months from the date of the denial, suspension, or revocation of the license under this Subsection.

- K.H. For any Applicant; Licensee; Owner; Operator; Child Care Worker; Resident; Volunteer, On- Site Non-Provider; spouse or significant other of an Owner presiding at the Premises, who has violated any of the provisions of this Chapter during licensure other than of 6-3-8(A) of this Chapter. No Applicant; Licensee; Owner; Operator; Child Care Worker; Resident; Volunteer, On-Site Non-Provider; spouse or significant other of an Owner presiding at the Child Care Facility shall be qualified to receive a license under this Chapter for a period of less than six (6) months from the date of the denial or revocation of the license under this Subsection.
- L. For any applicant who has a current active arrest warrant for a crime which, if convicted, would subject them to the limitations in this section. Nothing in this section shall be interpreted to disqualify any applicant who
 - 1. Is or has been merely charged with a disqualifying crime; or
 - 2. Has had a disqualifying criminal charge dismissed; or
 - 3. Has been found not guilty of a disqualifying crime.
- M.I. The applicant falsifies, omits, or otherwise intentionally misrepresents any information on the application. An applicant who has falsifies, omits, or otherwise intentionally misrepresents any information on the application shall be ineligible to reapply for licensing for a period of forty-two (42) days.

SECTION 2. Savings and Severability Clause. The provisions and parts of this Ordinance are intended to be severable. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Codification Clause. The Clerk is instructed to immediately forward this Ordinance to the codifier of the official municipal code for proper revision of the Code.

SECTION 4. Publication. This Ordinance, or a summary thereof in compliance with Idaho Code, shall be published once in the official newspaper of the City.

SECTION 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication, and on the _____ day of ______, 2023.

Description, Background Information & Purpose

On April 22, 2021, the City adopted Resolution No. 2021-11 to initiate legal proceedings to acquire property adjacent to the Idaho Falls Regional Airport ("Airport") for the expansion, improvement, or protection of the Airport. Resolution 2022-16 was adopted in order to correct an obvious scrivener's error to Resolution No 2021-11, to clarify the City's legal authority, and did not substantively change any decision or action taken to date by Council. Both Resolution No. 2021-11 and Resolution 2022-16 identified that the land to be acquired was owned by Johnson Legacy, LLC, and identified that property by the correct Bonneville County tax parcel number (RP02N37E014248).

As the condemnation legal action proceeded, an error in the legal description of the property was discovered. This resolution corrects that error and includes the revised legal description in its Resolution No. 2021-11 and No. 2022-16 and, to such, reaffirms that the prior Resolutions authorized the acquisition of the entire parcel of land owned by Johnson Legacy, LLC, as identified by Bonneville County tax parcel number RP02N37E014248. This resolution does not substantively change prior Resolutions No. 2021-11 and No. 2022-16 or any decision or action taken to date by the Council related to them or their respective intent and, as such, will relate-back to the date of the original Resolution No. 2021-11.

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, CLARIFYING RESOLUTION NO. 2021-11 AND RESOLUTION NO. 2022-16, WHICH ORDERS THE CONDEMNATION OF PROPERTY FOR EXPANSION, IMPROVEMENT, AND PROTECTION OF THE IDAHO FALLS REGIONAL AIRPORT; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS RESOLUTION BE EFFECTIVE UPON ITS PASSAGE, APPROVAL, AND PUBLICATION ACCORDING TO LAW.

WHEREAS, commercial air flights have flown in and out of the location currently occupied by the Idaho Falls Regional Airport (IFRA) since the mid 1930's; and

WHEREAS, the Airport is a vital part of regional economic development and provides easy access to and from the City, County, and region; and

WHEREAS, City desires to maintain, operate, and protect its Airport as a vital asset, an important economic engine, and as a principle transportation hub in the region; and

WHEREAS, the airport master plan, adopted by the Airport in October 15, 2010, and by the Council, identifies critical areas to Airport operations that require additional land to expand, improve, or protect the Airport; and

WHEREAS, the City has acquired real property adjacent to the airport to expand, improve, and protect the Airport; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to acquire additional real property adjacent to the Airport in order to continue to expand, improve, and protect the Airport; and

WHEREAS the City has sought to negotiate in good faith for the purchase of the property and has made fair-market offers, supported by appraisals conducted and reviewed by a licensed real property appraisers; and

WHEREAS, the City has been unable to reach an agreement to purchase the real property adjacent to the Airport; and

WHEREAS, the real property is necessary to expand, improve, and protect the IFRA; and

WHEREAS, the City has general eminent domain authority to acquire real property for public purposes pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 7-701 and 50-321; and

WHEREAS, the City has explicit statutory authority under Idaho Code § 21-401 to exercise the power of eminent domain and condemnation for the purpose to take over and hold lands within or without the boundaries or corporate limits of the City for the purpose of maintaining aviation fields, airports, hangers, and other air navigation facilities, among other purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City's authority to extraterritorial eminent domain power to build or maintain airport, aviation, or air navigation facilities, etc., was noted as a legitimate and appropriate by the United States Court of Appeals, Ninth Circuit, in *Alliance for Property Rights and Fiscal Responsibility v. City of Idaho Falls*, 742 F.3d 1100, 1104 (9th Cir. 2013); and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of the property is most compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2021-11, adopted April 22, 2021, mistakenly made reference to Idaho Code § 50-320(A), which authorizes Idaho's cities to acquire property for cemeteries instead of Idaho Code § 50-321, which authorizes Idaho's cities to acquire property for airport purposes; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of Resolution No. 2022-16 was to correct an obvious scrivener's error to Resolution No 2021-11 and to clarify and confirm what was intended in the original Resolution, mainly that the City possesses the authority to exercise the power of eminent domain and that the City's actions to expand, improve and protect the Airport is a public use authorized by law. Resolution No. 2022-16 did not substantively change the prior Resolution or any decision or action taken to date by Council and as such will relate-back to the date of the original Resolution; and

WHEREAS, while the City's prior Resolution No. 2021-11 and No. 2022-16 authorized the acquisition of the entire parcel of land owned by Johnson Legacy, LLC, as identified by Bonneville County tax parcel number RP02N37E014248, an error was discovered in the legal description of the property; and

WHEREAS, the City has corrected that error and seeks to include the revised legal description in its Resolution No. 2021-11 and No. 2022-16 and, to such, reaffirm that the prior Resolutions authorized the acquisition of the entire parcel of land owned by Johnson Legacy, LLC, as identified by Bonneville County tax parcel number RP02N37E014248; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution does not substantively change prior Resolution No. 2021-11 and No. 2022-16 or any decision or action taken to date by the Council related to them or their respective intent and, as such, will relate-back to the date of the original Resolution No. 2021-11.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City exercise its Eminent Domain authority to condemn the property identified by Bonneville County tax parcel number RP02N37E014248, and more particularly described in Exhibit "A."

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
